

PORTABLE SAWMILL

General Conditions

Students must be trained in the proper procedures for the setup, operation, shutdown and maintenance of the portable sawmill. The student must demonstrate the ability to follow the teacher's and manufacturers' instructions, pass the safety test and be "Shop Ready". The portable sawmill must have wheels chocked, outriggers positioned and on level ground.

Personal Protective Equipment

- Safety glasses/face shield
- CSA Approved hard hat
- Hearing protection-ear plugs or ear muffs (CSA Approved)
- Foot protection- green patch boots (CSA Approved)
- Gloves
- Long pants
- Safety vest

- Flying debris
- Dust
- Vibration
- Burns from exhaust
- Entanglement
