


Navigate to https://www.tinkercad.com/

If you don't already have an account, create one by clicking here




Click "Educators start here" to create an educator account, and agree to terms







If you sign up with email, you'll be asked to provide your birth date










This is your home screen once you've logged in.


You can click on this <u>icon</u> at any time to return to this screen.




On this screen, you can create a class so that your students can log in.




Scroll down the page and click on the "Add your students through Tinkercad Classroom_to build your class.



Click on the "Create new class" button.




Fill in the required details

Click on Add Students to populate your class.







Once you've added all of your students, you can go back to your class.

At this point, you'll need to click on Class Code to get the link to share with your students.




You can copy the code or the link to share with your students so that they can launch Tinkercad.



Your students will need their nicknames to login once they reach the site from the link.


To get their nicknames, go back to the list of students in your class. If you click on their nickname, it copies onto the clipboard, and can be pasted into another document (spreadsheet or table) of your student logins.




As a teacher, if you're new to 3D Design, there are very helpful lessons that will get you up and running in this environment in no time.
